

# MEDICAID FOR BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER

## About Medicaid for Breast and Cervical Cancer

Medicaid for Breast and Cervical Cancer (MBCC) offers full Medicaid benefits including cancer treatments and breast reconstruction for women who are eligible. These services are administered in the STAR+PLUS program through a Managed Care Organization of the member's choice.

### Who is eligible?

You may qualify for MBCC services if you:

- Have been diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer.
- Need treatment for breast or cervical cancer.
- Live in Texas.
- Are a U.S. citizen or eligible immigrant.
- Are age 18 to 64.
- Do not have health insurance.
- Make less than the monthly family income limit.

### What benefits are available?

The MBCC program will connect you with a service coordinator to help you:

- Identify and address medical needs.
- Understand Medicaid benefits.
- Receive access to needed specialty services.
- Coordinate community supports, including services that might be non-medical or not covered by Medicaid.



### What is the monthly family income limit?

### How do I apply for Medicaid for Breast and Cervical Cancer?

Only Breast and Cervical Cancer Services (BCCS) providers can submit MBCC applications. To find a BCCS provider who can help you with your MBCC application:
